No.**Hadith**

6493 The Prophet used to invoke Allah in his prayer, "O Allah! Save 'Aiyash bin Rabi'a, Salama bin Hisham and Walid bin Walid from the cruelty of infidels. ---- O Allah! Save the weak among the believers. ---- O Allah! Be hard upon the tribe of Muzar and inflict years of famine upon them, like the famine years of Prophet Yusuf."

Narrated: Abu Hurairah.

6494 Allah's Prophet said, "Whoever possesses three qualities will have the delight of faith: 1) The one to whom Allah and His Prophet becomes dearer than anything else; 2) Who loves a person but loves him only for Allah's Sake; 3) Who hates to revert to atheism (*disbelief*) as he hates to be thrown into the Fire." *Narrated: Anas.*

6495 (*Before 'Umar himself embraced Islam*), I have seen myself tied and forced by 'Umar to leave Islam. And now the situation is, if the mountain of Uhad were to collapse for the evil which you people had done to 'Uthman, then Uhad would have the right to do so." *Narrated: Saeed bin Zaid.*

No.**Hadith**

6496 Allah's Prophet was leaning against his sheet cloak in the shade of the Ka'bah. We reached him and complained that why don't you ask Allah to help us? Why don't you invoke Allah for us. The Prophet said, "Among those who were before you (*a believer*) used to be seized, and a pit used to be dug for him and then he used to be placed in it. Then a saw used to be brought and put on his head which would split into two halves. All sorts of cruelties he had to face, yet all that did not cause him to revert from his religion. ---- By Allah! This religion (*Islam*) will be completed till a traveller goes from Sana'a' (*the capital of Yemen*) to Hadaramout fearing nobody except Allah. Do not be impatient."

6497 While we were in the mosque, Allah's Prophet came out to us and said, "Let us proceed to meet the Jews." So we went along with him till we reached Bait-al-Midras (*a place where the Torah used to be recited and all the Jews of the town used to gather*). The Prophet stood up and addressed them, "O Assembly of Jews! Embrace Islam and you will be safe! You should know that this earth belongs to Allah and His Prophet. I want to exile you from this land, so whoever among you owns some property, can sell it. The Noble Prophet repeated this statement three times. *Narrated: Abu Hurairah.*

6498 My father gave me in marriage when I was a matron and I disliked that marriage. So I came and complained to the Prophets and he declared that marriage invalid.

Narrated: Khansa' bint Khidam Ansariya.

6499 I asked the Prophet, "O Allah's Prophet! Should the women be asked for their consent to their marriage?" He said, "Yes." I said, "A virgin, if asked, feels shy and keeps quiet." He said, "Her silence means her consent." *Narrated: 'Aisha.*

6500 A man from the Ansar made his slave, a Mudabbar. This news reached to Allah's Prophet and he said, "Who will buy this slave from me?" So Nu'aim bin Niham bought him for 800 Dirham. That slave was a Coptic slave who died same year.

Hadith

6501 Ibn 'Abbas gave the need of the Divine Revelation of Surah Nisa, Verse-19. Before this revelation, if a man died, his relatives used to have the right to inherit his wife. It was on their wishes to marry or not marry her.

Narrated: Shaibani.

6502 Allah's Prophet said, "The Prophet Ibrahim migrated with his wife Sarah till he reached a town where there was a king or a tyrant, who sent a message to Ibrahim, ordering him to send Sarah to him. So when Ibrahim had sent Sarah, the tyrant got up, intending to do evil with her. She reached there, and first she performed ablution and prayed and invoked for her safety. Allah saved her with king's evil intensions.

6503 Allah's Prophet said, "A Muslim is a brother of another Muslim and fulfils the needs of his brother. So he should neither oppress him nor hand him over to an oppressor."

6504 Allah's Prophet said, "Help your brother, whether he is an oppressor or an oppressed," A man said, "O Allah's Prophet! I will help him if he is oppressed, but if he is an oppressor, how shall I help him?" The Prophet said, "By preventing him from oppressing others, that is how to help him."
