Dealing with Apostates

(مرتداوردشمن کی توبہ)

[لَا تُشْرِكْ بِاللَّهِ إِنَّ الشِّرْكَ لَظُلْمٌ عَظِيمٌ، (31:13)]

[لَنْ أَشْرَكَتَ لِيَحْبِطَنَّ عَمَلُكَ وَلَتَكُونَنَّ مِنَ الْخَاسِرِينَ، (39:65)]

[الَّذِينَ آمَنُوا وَلَمْ يَلْبِسُوا إِيمَانَهُمْ بِظُلْمٍ أُولَئِكَ لَهُمُ الْأَمْنُ وَهُمْ مُهْتَدُونَ، (06:82)]

6473

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{Those who believed and did not mix it with injustice (disbelief), the refuge is only for them, and only they are on guidance (06:82)}

When the above Verse was revealed, it became very hard on the Companions of the Prophet, and they said, "Who among us has not confused his belief with oppression?" On that, Prophet said, "Don't you listen to Luqman's statement:

إِنَّ الشِّرْكَ لَظُلْمٌ عَظِيمٌ

{Joining others in worship with Allah is a great wrong indeed. (31.13)}. *Narrated: 'Abdullah.*

6474/6475

The Prophet. said, "To join others in worship with Allah, to be undutiful to one's parents, to take false oath and to give false witness are the biggest of the great sins.

Narrated: 'Abdur Rahman bin Abu Bakr and 'Abdullah bin 'Umer.

Allah's Prophet was asked, "Shall we be punished for what we did in the Pre-Islamic Period?" The Noble Prophet said, "Whoever does good in Islam will not be punished, but whoever does evil in Islam will be punished for his former and later bad deeds."

Narrated: Ibn Masood.

6477 Ibn Abbas narrates that the Noble Prophet said, "Whoever changed his Islamic religion, do not punish anybody by burning, rather kill him." *Narrated: 'Ikrima.*

6478 Two men reached to the Prophet and they begged to make themselves as *عامل (Governor)*. The Prophet said, "We never appoint for our affairs anyone who seeks to be employed. He further said, "Whoever changed his Islamic religion, kill that apostate. *Narrated: Abu Musa 'Ash'ari.*

6479 When Abu Bakr became the first Caliphate, some of the Arabs reverted to disbelief. Abu Bakr said, 'I am going to fight these people till they say: 'None has the right to be worshipped but Allah'. He said. "By Allah! I will fight whoever make different the Prayers and Zakat. Zakat is the right to be taken from property. By Allah! If they refused to pay me even a kid of the goat they used to pay to Allah's Prophet, I would fight with them for withholding it."
'Umar said, "By Allah: I noticed that Allah opened Abu Bakr's chest towards the decision to fight, therefore I realized that his decision was right."

Narrated: Abu Hurairah.

6480to6482 (*When Jews greet they used to say *الماتم عليكم* means death be on you. So Prophet said when you reply them simply say *وعليكم* means and on you as well*): This is a repeated hadith. See hadith-5852/5853. *Narrated: Anas bin Malik, 'Aisha and Ibn 'Umar.*

6483 I was looking at the Prophet while he was speaking about one of the prophets whose people have beaten and wounded him, and he was wiping the blood off his face and saying, "O Lord! Forgive my people as they are unaware."

Narrated: 'Abdullah.

6484to6488 (*The gist of these hadith is*):

Allah's Prophet said, "During Last Days, there will appear a nation Harooriya or Khawarij. Among them young foolish people will say the best words but their faith will not go beyond their throats (*in fact they will have no faith*). From this nation, a group of people will appear so pious that you will consider your prayers and fasts are inferior to their prayers

and fasts. But, they will go out of Islam as an arrow darts out of the game's body. These people will come out making disputes. Wherever you find such people, kill them. Whoever kills them will receive his reward on the Day of Judgment.

Narrated: 'Ali, 'Ata, 'Abdullah bin 'Umar Abu Saeed and Yaseer bin 'Amr.

- 6489 Allah's Prophet said, "The Last Hour will not be established till two huge groups fight against each other with, their claim being one and the same." *Narrated: Abu Hurairah.*
- 6490 *(Sharing with Allah is a greatest sin):* This is a repeated hadith. See hadith- 6473 above. *Narrated: 'Abdullah.*
- 6491 The Prophet said, Whoever will say "None has the right to be worshipped but Allah and Muhammad is His Prophet, only for Allah's sake, on the Day of Resurrection, Allah will save him from the Hell-Fire." As regards hypocrisy, you leave this matter to Allah.
- Narrated: 'Atban bin Malik*
- 6492 *(Hatib wrote a letter to the Pagan of Makkah and informed about the current details of the Prophet. When the Prophet came to know he had a query session then he forgave him by saying, "he is from Badr"):* This is a repeated hadith. See hadith-2805.
- Narrated: Sa'ad Bin 'Ubaida.*
